

THE NEW ZEALAND ASSOCIATION OF RADIO TRANSMITTERS NEW ZEALAND LAKE SIDE AWARD



The New Zealand Lakeside Award is designed to promote operation from New Zealand's scenic fresh water lakes and to stimulate mobile and portable operation. The award is open to all amateur radio operators.

The Rules

1. For the Basic Award, contacts are required with stations operating on the shores of ten freshwater lakes in New Zealand. There are 50 valid North Island Lakes and 195 valid South Island Lakes to choose from.
2. An Honour Award is available for contacts with 50 or more lakes. Endorsements are available for each additional group of ten lakes.
3. Stations must be located on or near the lake shore.
4. For stations activating lakeside sites. The Basic Award is awarded for 30 contacts with stations seeking to complete the award. You must supply each contact with the name of the lake. There is an endorsement for activating two or more lakes. The Honour Award is awarded for 100 contacts with stations seeking to complete the award. For the Honour Award you must activate at least five valid lakes and you must supply each contact with the name of the lake.
5. Contacts can be made on any band or mode, but not via repeaters.
6. This Log Sheet or the associated Excel file MUST be used when applying for the New Zealand lakeside Award.

RULES FOR ALL NZART AWARDS

1. NZART stresses the 'honour system.' Award applicants do not have to hold QSL cards for claimed contacts. It is sufficient to merely certify that the QSO was legitimately made. This rule applies to all NZART sponsored awards, including the IARU Region III award.
2. QSOs made by IRLP, Echolink, or other web-based communication are not acceptable for any award. All QSOs must be by two-way conversation made by radio.
3. Cross-band operation is not acceptable for any awards.
4. Awards are open to SWL (shortwave listeners) as well as amateur radio operators.

APPLYING FOR NZART AWARDS

When applying for any award please observe the following:

1. PRINT your name, address and call-sign very clearly.
2. Supply a checking log sheet with the call signs, date of each QSO, mode, band, and any other information required for the award. Excel files are preferred but scanned copies, paper, pdf, or other files are acceptable.
3. You can apply for awards by email to awards@nzart.org.nz and pay via PayPal to the same address. Or you can post applications with payment included to The NZART Awards Manager, PO BOX 1733, Christchurch 8140, New Zealand. Cheques, IRCs, and postage stamps are not accepted.
4. The award costs \$5.00 for stations located in New Zealand and \$6.00 USD, AUD, or UKP for DX stations.
