NEW ZEALAND LAKE SIDE AWARD

1. This award (NZLA) is designed to publicise the fresh water lakes of New Zealand and to stimulate mobile and or portable operation.
2. For the Basic Award, confirmations are required from amateur stations operating on the shores of 10 fresh water lakes in NZ.
Endorsements for each additional 10 lakes worked (up to 40) are available, with Special Honour Award for 50 and more, again with endorsements for each additional 10.
3. A station may be counted for this award if it is located within one kilometre of the water, or in a town on the lake shore. In the event of a station being within one kilometre of two lakes at the same time, then only one lake can be worked, designated by the operator of the station concerned.
4. A portable/mobile station operating from a lake shore may claim that lake for his own credit.
5. A lake for this award shall be defined as a body of fresh water having an area exceeding one square kilometre and marked on a Department of Survey and Land Information map of New Zealand.
6. Applications for this award MUST be made on these check sheets, which lists eligible lakes. This list will be returned with any award applied for and used as a permanent record for the applicant.
7. QSL cards should NOT be sent to the Awards Manager.
8. Costs: Basic Award NZ \$3.00, A \$5.00, US \$5.00 or 5 IRC. Endorsements NZ SASE, overseas US \$2.00 or 2 IRC.
Honour Award NZ \$3.00, A \$5.00, US \$5.00 or 5 IRC. Endorsements NZ SASE, overseas US \$2.00 or 2 IRC.
9. All applications to NZART Awards Manager, PO Box 1733, Christchurch Mail Centre, Christchurch 8140, New Zealand.
10. Eligible contacts for this award must date 1 May 1976 or later.
11. Lakes may be added or removed from this list from time to time due to hydro-electric and drainage developments around New Zealand. Amendments will be published in Break-In, and added to new lists as they are printed. Existing list may be updated by the holder as amendments are published.
