Stolen Ham Repeater

Waikato VHF Group Inc. equipment
Discovered missing from Te Uku radio site
11 January 2017

Stolen some time between 19 December 2016 and 1 January 2017.

Missing '5675 Repeater equipment:

1. **Icom FR5000 repeater shelf** S/N 0301064, containing FR5000 VHF repeater module S/N 0301189 and UR6000 UHF link module S/N 4104538. See photo below, labelled on front "Rx 145.075MHz, Tx 145.675MHz". Also labelled on back with frequencies and trustee contact phone numbers. Two patch cables with DB25 metal-shelled connectors attached to back of this item, cable was cut on one (other end was left plugged into associated equipment).



2. **153.925MHz Notch Filter** in 64x58x35mm diecast box with 2x N sockets (see photos below). This was attached to VHF Repeater Rx port via N male-male barrel connector (also missing).



3. **VHF Circulator** (labelled "146MHz") plus **Cellwave AL015B 15W load** attached to a **bracket mounting these items** off the left side of the FR5000 shelf, along with a **RG142 jumper cable** terminated each end with type 'N' plugs having green boots. See photo below.

The one I used to have had chemically blackened cast alloy brackets and lever and the side terminal screws were hexagon sided with a screwdriver slot, rather than knurled.
