New Zealand ISP's block NZART E-mails

NOTE 05-April-2009: As Webmaster, my returned e-mail lists from the NZART mail server, have not reported a rejected clear or paradise e-mail since Monday, 30 March 2009 6:32 p.m. Checks before sending this Infoline reveal that all is back to normal and the block on NZART.ORG.NZ has been removed. ED

ClearNet and Paradise users who have an alias e-mail address `callsign@nzart.org.nz`- will find it does not work and the e-mails returned to the sender.

The block put on by ClearNet has been done because of the amount of Spam originating from the mail server used to host the -NZART.ORG.NZ- domain.

Clear, Paradise and other TelstraClear e-mail clients will not receive mail from any NZART reflector.

NZART Council with the assistance of the Webmaster is looking in to this matter with a view to resolve the matter as soon as possible with the Hosting Company that provides the mail server service.

To ensure a continuation of HQ InfoLine, an alternative e-mail system will be used.

A Fix Has Been Suggested

To fix this send a mail from one's clear account to
(`Call@nzart.org.nz`,`notspam@clear.net.nz`)

Note carefully the COMMA between the nz and notspam.
