Fibre-to-the Home (FttH)

Our NZ government made announcements in the media recently about connecting Fibre to the Home (FttH). Such a move will deflate major BPL/amateur radio interference possibilities – but it still leaves the in-house use of BPL (by neighbours!) as an interference threat to amateur radio activities.
