The good news is - **all** existing members who have paid their 2003 subscription by 31 December 2002 will also be eligible to go into the prize draw.

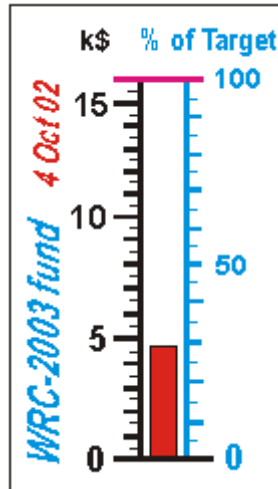
